Re: Update on the Books

Thank you again so much for the donation you shared with us. We are ensuring that we do the needful. Attached is a video following our journey thus far.

Once the books arrived we started with Book sorting; we even held a Sip and Stamp party and invited friends and strangers to join us and we had over 20 people stamping and repackaging on that day.

From there we had activation pop up stalls and gave away books to create interest around our intended National Book drive. We have since held 3 handover sessions.

We donated over 5000 books to local primary schools in Gaborone (the capital city), a church, the local National Nursing school and Children's oncology ward in the local hospital to set up reading corners and increase their library books.

We are also setting up a Community Reading Centre at one of the Local parks and have donated 2000 books to them. We are still looking for a partner to donate a prefab room or some kind of shelter to set up the library in and we are hopeful.

We also donated over 4000 books to the University of Botswana through the Vice Chancellors office. We donated to the health sciences department and also donated primary and secondary school books to them to share with their adopted public schools.

We are still intending to go on a National Book drive around the country distributing the books to public schools and libraries in different areas. We are currently in talks with a local bank to collaborate in this and have so far done one handover with them at a school they have adopted.

So we thought we would just fill you in on how it has been going so far. Thank you once again for the donation it will definitely make a mark.
